Judge Jagdmann is currently serving her third term as Commissioner. She is a graduate of the University of Virginia and the University of Richmond School of Law. Prior to being elected to the Commission in 2006, she was the 43rd Attorney General for the Commonwealth of Virginia, serving from 2005-2006. From 1998-2005, Jagdmann served as the Deputy Attorney General for the Civil Litigation Division, a position that included the Anti-trust and Utility Consumer Counsel Divisions. Before her work in the Office of Attorney General, she served as counsel to the SCC and its staff on securities and utility matters. She became President of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) in October 2021. Past NARUC positions include leading the Electricity Committee and the Task Force on Military Workforce Development. Regional leadership includes serving as President of the Mid-Atlantic Conference of Regulatory Utilities Commissioners (2017-18) and as the Virginia member of the Organization of PJM States, Inc. As adjunct faculty, she teaches energy policy and regulation at the University of Virginia School of Law.
